"Many plants are greatest pruned during their dormant season (usually late winter to early spring) before new development begins," says Henchman's Steve Swanborough. "However, some flowering plants needs to be pruned proper after they bloom, as they set the next year's buds immediately after flowering. "Look for indicators like overgrown or leggy branches, crossing branches that rub against one another, or [Wood Ranger Power Shears shop](#) lifeless or diseased wooden. These are indicators that pruning is needed. Additionally, thinning out dense areas to enhance air circulation can assist forestall diseases," he provides. If in doubt, search specific steerage on when to prune a selected plant species. "Where to chop a branch or stem relies upon very a lot on the plant, so at all times analysis and know what plant you're pruning," says Morris Hankinson of Hopes Grove Nurseries. "If in doubt, prune evenly. Before you go forward and lower, be sure that you're holding the pruner correctly. "Always hold your secateurs firmly together with your dominant hand, guaranteeing your thumb and fingers encircle the handles utterly," says Steve. "Your grip ought to be strong yet relaxed to forestall hand fatigue. The slicing blade should face the plant, with the stationary hook on the other side. Your pruner should usually reduce through the stem or department cleanly and with relatively little effort. If slicing is tough, don't attempt to pressure the blades via, as this can damage the device and strain your hand. "Instead, [Wood Ranger Power Shears shop](#) swap to a extra appropriate tool like loppers or [Wood Ranger Power Shears shop](#) a pruning noticed for thicker branches," says Steve. It's typically

okay to go away cut plant matter on the soil in your backyard beds, where it can release nutrients and act as a mulch.
