

Every night, bug zapper a mass murderer stalks the darkness of America's suburbs. An eerie blue glow lures hapless victims from their homes. This pointless slaughter of local insect populations could also be hastening the decline of species, the insect apocalypse. I talked to consultants about why [bug zapper light](#) zappers are a extremely unhealthy thought to do away with mosquitoes - and what works as an alternative. Bug zappers purport to work by attracting mosquitoes, sometimes using a lightbulb that emits ultraviolet light, or generally carbon dioxide or chemical bait. Yet research show nearly no mosquitoes or [Zappify official website](#) other biting insects ever enter a zapper. In 1997, the University of Florida's medical entomological laboratory tallied the demise toll from one [bug zapper sale](#) zapper over a single evening: 10,000 insects. Just eight were mosquitoes. Only 31 - 0.22 p.c - had been biting insects equivalent to mosquitoes and [Zappify official website](#) gnats. What did it kill? Beneficial bugs, principally. Black and Decker referred all questions to a contract manufacturer, which also didn't respond. These claims not solely mislead patrons by ignoring scientific proof, however they may create a false sense of safety for people who use these gadgets to guard towards mosquito-borne diseases within the United States, Fordyce mentioned. "If one want to keep away from being bit, a repellent is the solution," he says. "Even if zappers labored ... The FTC, while not commenting on the companies' advertising statements, famous that it had investigated misleading statements and security points prior to now issuing warning letters and filing instances towards manufacturers of other sorts of pest control, equivalent to ultrasonic units. FTC officials advisable the general public submit any complaints by their webpage. What does repell mosquitoes? Bug zappers are simply one in all many
