

Alexandra is the Spring Blossom Festival city in the golden heart of Central Otago. This engaging town nestles at the head of Lake Roxburgh and is affectionately referred to as 'Alex', by the locals. It is the industrial centre for a affluent fruit growing and farming area. The world's most interesting merino wool is produced right here and in September each year the annual Golden [Wood Ranger Power Shears order now](#) Championships are held.
